The following is the wording for the bank guarantee.

Carnet Bank Guarantee

In consideration of the Dublin Chamber of Commerce issuing ATA or CPD China
Taiwan Carnet number* _____ to (*insert name of firm*)

in accordance with arrangements made under the Customs Convention on ATA Carnets for the temporary admission of goods, done at Brussels on 6 December 1961 (ATA Convention) and/or as the Appendix I to Annex A of the Convention on Temporary Admission, adopted in Istanbul on 26 June 1990 (Istanbul Convention) and/or the agreement on the organization of a system of international customs deposits with China-Taiwan for the temporary admission of goods done at Taipei on December 29th 1990.

We guarantee payment to you on demand of all or any such sum or sums of money as you may have paid or are called upon to pay in respect of customs duties and other charges relating to goods imported into any country concerned under cover of the Carnet (as well as any fee therefore) which this guarantee applies and such demand shall constitute sufficient evidence that moneys demanded by you are due and payable by us without further enquiry. Our liability hereunder shall be limited to a payment not exceeding _____ in the aggregate.

Instructions for completing the guarantee.

- 1.** The guarantee should be written on the official notepaper of the Guarantor.
- 2.** An official representing the guaranteeing body, who has authority to do so, should sign the Guarantee; the capacity of the signatory must be shown.
- 3.** The signature of the official mentioned at **2** above should be witnessed.
- 4.** The guarantee must be dated and have no expiry date.
