

## **NOTE TO THE HOLDER**

It is the responsibility of the **ATA Carnet Holder** to produce the carnet at any relevant customs point in order to get the Carnet stamped on entry into and exit from a destined country.

It is of great importance to note that duties and taxes may be demanded on the goods being imported into a country if the Carnet is not stamped correctly by customs.

The customs authorities have **ONE YEAR** after the expiry of the Carnet to raise a query and in turn to demand payment of duties if the carnet has not been stamped. These payments are the responsibility of the Carnet Holder.

Deposits and guarantees are held by Dublin Chamber of Commerce until the carnet is returned correctly stamped and are then returned **on request**.

Carnet deposits not claimed by the holder after 3 years from expiry of carnet will cease to be refundable
