

# GDA Overview

## The Greater Dublin Area (GDA)



Home to **four out of every ten people** in Ireland



**Half** of Ireland's GDP



Accounts for **three fifths of tax** revenue generated by Value Added, Corporate and Capital Gains tax



Workers in the GDA pay **60%** of all PAYE and USC tax



Accounts for **53%** of all self employed income tax



The GDA is a leader in Further and Higher Education, with institutions such as Dublin City University, Maynooth University, Trinity College Dublin, TU Dublin, and University College Dublin, along with private colleges like Dublin Business School, Griffith College, the Irish Management Institute, and the National College of Ireland.

Dublin is home to over one third of all active enterprises in Ireland and 60% of all large active enterprises employing more than 250 people.

Dublin Port handles almost 60% of all trade in the Republic of Ireland.

Dublin welcomes 3.9m tourists each year, spending 5-6 nights in the city on average and generating €2.3bn in revenue.

36.43 million passengers passed through Dublin Airport's terminals in 2025. It supported 116,100 jobs in the Republic of Ireland in 2022 and contributed a total of €9.6 billion in gross value added (GVA) to the Irish economy.




